

Which areas are covered from Filey and Eastfield Police Stations?

The areas in blue and yellow – covered from Eastfield Police station. Areas in green – covered from Filey Police Station.



There were 218 incidents reported in your area during February. Incidents of note are as follows: -

05/02/2025 13:28 – A blue moped failed to stop for traffic officers on Lingholm Crescent in Eastfield. The bike was lost around Cayton Low Road. The rider was wearing shorts and a red helmet. Please report any information on who this rider may be and quote incident 12250022254.

10/02/2025 20:10 – An abandoned red moped was located by Officers on Dale Edge. It was seized to prevent it being ridden illegally.

15/02/2025 16:57 – A large disturbance was reported from a Pizza shop on High Street in Eastfield. One local youth has so far been arrested for assault and a public order offence, he was later bailed with conditions to prevent him causing further issues. There is another local male due to be interviewed before a decision will be made on charges.

15/02/2025 19:54 – A disturbance was reported at Lowfield flats. Officers attended and arrested one male on suspicion of criminal damage and possession of an offensive weapon – a hammer.

17/02/2025 14:07 – A serious assault was reported on Ploughman's Court in Eastfield. One person was arrested and one person taken to hospital with serious head injuries. The incident is still under investigation.

18/02/2025 18:54 – A vehicle was stopped by Officers on patrol on Westway. The car has no insurance so it was seized and driver reported for this offence.

18/02/2025 - 22/02/2025 – Seven, overnight commercial burglaries were reported in the Scarborough area over a 5 day period. 3 of these were reported in the Filey & Eastfield Police areas. A hastily put together Police operation early on Sunday 23rd February, coupled with some superb work by two PCSOs resulted in 5 people from Lancashire and Devon being arrested in two separate vehicles as they were leaving Scarborough. All 5 suspects were interviewed and bailed to not come back to North Yorkshire apart from to answer their bail later in the year. 19/02/2025 07:59 – A male was arrested after being reported to be trying door handles to houses in the Eastfield and Crossgates area. Due to injuries sustained prior to Police contact, he had to be taken to hospital and will be dealt with in due course for any offences identified.

19/02/2025 19:02 – A drunk male who claimed to have a knife tried to get on a bus at top shops. He was located on Cayton Low Road and arrested on suspicion of possession oof an offensive weapon – no knife was located on him. Upon arrest, he also had two unprescribed Valium tablets on him so was arrested for possession of Class C drugs. The male was bailed to make further enquiries into the initial suggestion that he had a knife.

20/02/2025 14:11 – Officers arrested a male on suspicion of drug possession and then entered a flat on Manham Hill where three further people and drugs were located. Four people were arrested in total, drugs recovered and all people dealt with for drug offences.
